

Instructions for Interacting with the Images in the Pissarro Research Catalogue

This research catalogue only functions in Chrome and Safari browsers.

Plate Image [first image in every entry]

In order to zoom in on the plate image, use the hover controls which appear when you place your mouse on the image in the upper right corner. Click on the revert button, the circular arrow on the lower left of the image, in order to return to the original view after zooming.

Multilayer Interactive Image Viewer [second image in every entry, always denoted with “interactive image”]

For the Multilayer Interactive Image Viewer, any pair of images may be selected in the slider bar, which may be moved to transition between the two layers.

The four-arrow icon in the lower-right corner can be used to switch from page view to full-image view. The circular arrow icon is used to revert to the image's default settings.

In the upper-right corner are the key to the activated annotations and a navigation arrow to orient the detail within the context of the overall image.

The vertical slider tool in the upper right is used to zoom into or out of the image. When viewing a detail of the overall, the image may be moved within the window by dragging it to the desired position.

Technical Images

These images may be selected by either clicking on the the figure reference (i.e. Fig. 1.2, Fig. 1.3) or by selected the “More” tab in the lower left corner.

The “More” tab contains every image within the entry. Images can be enlarged by selected the magnifying glass icon in the lower right of each image.
